

GOING GREEN

St. Mark's council decided to go **GREEN** this past year and we are making a difference one step at a time.

First, we started to recycle any bulletins that you did not want to take home after each service by putting them in the basket marked (**RECYCLED BULLETINS**) located at the top of the steps.

Second, the kitchen is going **GREEN** where possible. Starting with our Lenten dinners, we are now using only 1 trash can and only 1 trash liner. This is helping reduce the purchasing of trash liners. By going **GREEN**, we have reduced our trash bags from 3 to 1 bag per night. As we were maxing out our trash containers outside, we now do not have to increase our waste removal budget by increasing our container to a larger one there for keeping within our church budget.

By working as a team, we here at St. Mark's can help reduce the materials that are filling our landfills and help keep within our church budget. Thank you St. Mark's members for all of your help.
