

## **A HABITAT OVERVIEW**

Several members of St. Mark's have asked about the agenda and workload involved with the build-days. To answer those questions, here's a rundown of a typical Habitat day. We meet up at the church parking lot around 7:30 a.m. and caravan to the build site. Most days include some hammering and lifting, but there are also other, less-strenuous duties that can be done, and there is always a professional site coordinator on-hand to assign projects and help implement them. We take two breaks, one in the morning and another for lunch, and usually wrap up between 2:30 and 3 p.m. Dress comfortably (jeans and sneakers or boots).
