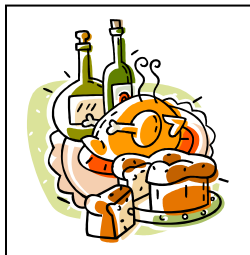


WELCOME ANIKA!!
