

## **MIDWIFE KIT PROJECT**

Midwife Kits will be assembled Sunday, Sept. 27 following the 11 am service - your help is needed for this meaningful project. These kits support Global Health Ministries, a Lutheran organization that provides basic health care in poor areas of the world, in areas where there may be little or no access to hospitals or doctors, and a local midwife may be the only person available to deliver babies. These midwife kits provide the basic necessities for the mother and baby.

Items still needed (may be new or gently used): infant T-shirts (size newborn or small), bed sheets, receiving blankets, infant hats, towels and washcloths. Towels and washcloths should be thin, not too thick. Also this year, we are accepting donations of flannel sheets and infant onesies (size newborn or small) which will be cut and sewn into receiving blankets and infant t-shirts.
