

WHAT IS A 'PRAYER-SQUARE' MINISTRY?

It is an interfaith outreach ministry that combines the gift of prayer with the gift of a hand-tied quilt. The purpose of this ministry is to promote prayer through the use of quilts.

"It's not about the quilt; it's all about the prayers."

Each prayer quilt is a special gift of love made for sick babies, cancer patients, AIDS patients, for adults and children facing surgery or personal crisis; for many reasons, but each is for someone in special need for prayer.

These quilts are made and the layers are tied with a square knot. As each knot is tied, a silent prayer is said for someone in special need, who then receives the finished quilt.

You don't need to know how to sew to participate in construction of any of these quilts. As well as sewers, we will need fabric donations, fabric sorters, fabric square cutters, label makers, gift cards to go with the quilts, and, of course, all members of the congregation can tie a knot and say a prayer when the quilts are ready to be tied.
